Logansport Mall Show

The 2011 Show season kicks off at the Logansport Mall on March 12-13. All tractors, garden tractors, engines, and pedal tractors are all welcome. There will be a pedal pull for the kids on Saturday at 5:00 p.m.

Tractors will be allowed into the mall only at 9:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11th and may not be moved out until after closing on Sunday evening. Trucks and trailers may be parked behind the mall during the weekend. The entrance for tractors is located on the back side (north) near JC Penney.

Hoosier Heritage Fest Preview

Hoosier Heritage Fest is August 19-21, 2011. The feature tractor is John Deere; however, all tractors, garden tractors, and engines are welcome.

Planning starts almost immediately after the previous year to continually make the event better and more interesting for all participants. Some big changes for 2011 include a Friday Night Tractor Pull and Saturday Night Tractor Games.

New demonstrations include corn shelling and a buzz saw. Wheat threshing and baling will continue to be a feature activity. The popular Tractor Drive will happen on Sunday morning, following the worship service. Plans are also underway for a Quilt Show, workshops, and field trips to nearby locations.

Many favorites will continue including the Kids' Pedal Pull, daily parades, craft and other booths, food vendors, and the Euchre tournament.
